These studies will help stir your thinking and solidify your convictions on topics that personally impact your life. Our initial study (approximately eight weeks) will focus heavily on the life of David and lessons we can learn from his life, worldly success vs. godly success, and the battle we all fight against our natural inclination to be self-sufficient.

Our format will include fellowship time, large group presentation/discussion, small group discussion/prayer, and another "Visual Bible" DVD on the Book of Acts.
